**ORDINANCE 2025-252-E**

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,042,284.14 FROM AMPHITHEATER (DAILY'S PLACE) AND FLEX FIELD REVENUES TO FUND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND MAINTENANCE NEEDS AT DAILY'S PLACE, AND UPDATING PRIOR APPROPRIATIONS TO REFLECT ACTUALS, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 25-036; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

**Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$1,042,284.14 of revenue collected from Amphitheater and Flex Field parking fees and ticket surcharges/facility fees to pay construction costs for capital improvements and maintenance needs at Daily's Place, and also updating prior

appropriations to reflect actuals.

**Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to utilize revenue earned at Daily's Place for capital improvements and maintenance needs at Daily's Place. In addition, the appropriation updates prior appropriations to reflect actuals.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
