RESOLUTION 2026-596

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING COUNCIL MEMBER MICHAEL BOYLAN TO THE DUVAL COUNTY ELECTION CANVASSING BOARD, AS A SUBSTITUTE MEMBER, PURSUANT TO SECTION 102.141(1)(C), *FLORIDA STATUTES*, FOR A TERM BEGINNING JULY 1, 2026, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2027; REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 102.141(1), *Florida Statutes*, establishes an Election Canvassing Board with the Chair of the Board of the County Commissioners as a member; and

WHEREAS, Section 102.141(1)(c), *Florida Statutes* provides for the selection of a substitute member if the Chair of the Board of the County Commissioners is unable to serve; and

WHEREAS, in the Consolidated City of Jacksonville, the Chair of the Board of the County Commissioners is the Jacksonville City Council President, whose term is July 1 to June 30; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appointment of Substitute to Election Canvassing Board. The Council hereby appoints Council Member Michael Boylan as a substitute member to the Duval County Election Canvassing Board, pursuant to Section 102.141(1)(c), *Florida Statutes*, for a term beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027.

Section 2. Requesting emergency passage upon introduction Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901. Emergency passage upon introduction of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is the need to have the Canvassing Board seated timely to prepare for the

1 election on August 18, 2026.

2 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
3 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
4 without the Mayor's signature.
