4 **ORDINANCE 2019-848**

5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,600,000.00 FROM  
6 TWO COUNTYWIDE PROJECTS, THE ROADWAY SIGN  
7 STRIPE AND SIGNAL PROJECT AND THE COUNTYWIDE  
8 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, TO TWO NEW  
9 SPECIFIC PROJECTS, THE PEARL STREET AND 44<sup>TH</sup>  
10 STREET INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AND  
11 THE UNIVERSITY BOULEVARD AND JACK ROAD  
12 PROJECT, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 20-025; AMENDING  
13 THE 2020-2024 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT  
14 PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2019-505-E TO  
15 REDUCE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECTS ENTITLED  
16 "ROADWAY SIGN STRIPE AND SIGNAL" AND  
17 "COUNTYWIDE INTERSECTION IMP & BRIDGE REHAB -  
18 INTERSECTIONS" AND PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE  
19 PROJECTS ENTITLED "PEARL STREET - 44<sup>TH</sup> STREET  
20 INTERSECTION" AND "UNIVERSITY BLVD -  
21 UNIVERSITY BLVD & JACK RD INTERSECTION IMP;"  
22 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

24 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

25 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,  
26 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
27 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
28 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

4 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

5 The funding above is a transfer of funds from two  
6 countywide projects, the Roadway Sign Stripe and Signal  
7 Project and the Countywide Intersection Improvements  
8 Project, to two new specific projects, the Pearl Street  
9 and 44<sup>th</sup> Street Intersection Improvements Project and the  
10 University Boulevard and Jack Road Project.

11 **Section 2. Purposes.** The Pearl Street and 44<sup>th</sup> Street  
12 Intersection Improvements Project is for the design and  
13 construction of a traffic signal and overhead fiber interconnect  
14 along East 44<sup>th</sup> Street between Pearl Street and Main Street. The  
15 design will include special emphasis crosswalks with upgraded ADA  
16 compliant ramps, pedestrian signal phasing, and extended left-turn  
17 bays on Pearl Street. The University Boulevard and Jack Road  
18 Project is for the design and construction of a traffic signal and  
19 overhead fiber interconnect along University Boulevard between  
20 Merrill Road and Fort Caroline Road. The design will include  
21 special emphasis crosswalks with upgraded ADA compliant ramps,  
22 pedestrian signal phasing, and coordination with both Arlington  
23 Community Redevelopment Area and Jacksonville University.

24 **Section 3. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2019-505-E, being  
25 the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City  
26 and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to  
27 reduce funding for the projects entitled "Roadway Sign Stripe and  
28 Signal" and "Countywide Intersection Imp & Bridge Rehab -  
29 Intersections" and provide funding for the projects entitled "Pearl  
30 Street - 44<sup>th</sup> Street Intersection" and "University Blvd - University  
31 Blvd & Jack Rd Intersection IMP." The projects are more fully

1 described in the Project Information Sheets, attached hereto as  
2 **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council  
3 finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next  
4 annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best  
5 interests of the community because such deferral will result in  
6 unnecessary delay in the installation of traffic infrastructure in  
7 critical areas. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*,  
8 enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-  
9 thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the  
10 CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall  
11 constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other  
12 respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by  
13 Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

14 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
15 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
16 without the Mayor's signature.
