

RULES AMENDMENT

The Rules Committee offers the following amendment to File No. 2026-221:

- (1) On **page 1, lines 13-19, strike** "2027, FOLLOWED BY A FIRST FULL TERM EXPIRING ON JUNE 30, 2031; ESTABLISHING SUBSTANTIAL BUSINESS OR PHILANTHROPIC INTEREST IN DUVAL COUNTY, PURSUANT TO SECTION 50.102(B) (MEMBERS OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), PART 1 (ORGANIZATION), CHAPTER 50 (ORGANIZATION OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), *ORDINANCE CODE*;" and **insert** "2027; WAIVING SECTION 50.102 (MEMBERS OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), PART 1 (ORGANIZATION), CHAPTER 50 (ORGANIZATION OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), *ORDINANCE CODE*, AS TO THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE APPOINTEE HAVE A SUBSTANTIAL ECONOMIC BUSINESS OR PHILANTHROPIC INTEREST WITHIN DUVAL COUNTY;"
- (2) On **page 2, lines 2-3, strike** "2027, followed by a first full term expiring June 30, 2031" and **insert** "2027";
- (3) On **page 2, lines 4-16, strike** all lines in their entirety and **insert** the following:

"Section 2. Waiver of Subsection 50.102(b), Ordinance Code. Subsection 50.102(b) (Residency Requirement), Section 50.102 (Members of boards and commissions), Part 1 (Organization), Chapter 50 (Organization of Boards and Commissions), *Ordinance Code*, is hereby waived as to the requirement that the appointee maintain a substantial economic business or philanthropic interest within Duval County."
- (4) On **page 2, line 17, strike** "52.106(a)," and **insert** "52.106(1),";

- (5) On **page 2, line 18, strike** "52.106(a)" and **insert** "52.106(1)";
- (6) On **page 2, lines 21-23, strike** "As noted above, Ms. Nazworth maintains substantial economic business interest within Duval County.";
- (7) On **page 1, line 1,** amend the introductory sentence to add that the bill was amended as reflected herein.
