7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$200,000.00 FROM  
8 THE PETCO FOUNDATION TO ASSIST THE CITY'S  
9 DIVISION OF ANIMAL CARE AND PROTECTIVE  
10 SERVICES IN INCREASING COMMUNITY AWARENESS AND  
11 THE ADOPTION RATE AT THE SHELTER, AS INITIATED  
12 BY REVISED B.T. 19-096; PROVIDING FOR A  
13 CARRYOVER OF FUNDS TO FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020;  
14 APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND  
15 CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER  
16 THE PETCO FOUNDATION GRANT INVESTMENT  
17 AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE PETCO  
18 FOUNDATION; AMENDING ORDINANCE 2018-504-E (THE  
19 CITY OF JACKSONVILLE BUDGET ORDINANCE) BY  
20 AMENDING ATTACHMENT A ("FOOD AND BEVERAGE  
21 EXPENDITURES") IN ORDER TO ALLOW FUNDS TO BE  
22 SPENT ON FOOD AND BEVERAGE AT SHELTER EVENTS;  
23 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE ANIMAL CARE AND  
24 PROTECTIVE SERVICES DIVISION OF THE  
25 NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN  
26 EFFECTIVE DATE.

28 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

29 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2018-2019 fiscal year,  
30 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the

1 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
2 the accounts listed in subsection (b):

3 (Revised B.T. 19-096, attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 1**, labeled  
4 as "Revised Exhibit 1, Revised B.T. 19-096, July 15, 2019 - NCSPHS"  
5 and incorporated herein by this reference):

10 (c) Explanation of appropriation:

11 The funding above is a grant award from The Petco  
12 Foundation appropriated to advertising and promotion,  
13 miscellaneous services and charges, and food to assist  
14 the City's Division of Animal Care and Protective  
15 Services in increasing community awareness and the  
16 adoption rate at the shelter. The grant does not require  
17 a City match and the grant end date is January 31, 2021.

18 **Section 2. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in Section 1  
19 of this ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into fiscal  
20 year 2019-2020.

21 **Section 3. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
22 Section 1 is to provide additional funds for shelter marketing  
23 campaigns, training seminars, volunteer appreciation events, event  
24 promotion, and fees associated with events.

25 **Section 4. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby  
26 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary  
27 are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, The Petco Foundation  
28 Grant Investment Agreement between the City and The Petco  
29 Foundation, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and  
30 incorporated herein by this reference.

31 **Section 5. Amending Ordinance 2018-504-E by amending**

1 **Attachment A ("Food and Beverage Expenditures")**. Ordinance 2018-  
2 504-E is amended by amending Attachment A thereto ("Food and  
3 Beverage Expenditures") by substituting a new Fourth Revised  
4 Attachment A, attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**, incorporated herein by  
5 this reference, and made a part of Ordinance 2018-504-E, in order  
6 to allow funds to be spent on food and beverages at shelter events.

7 **Section 6. Oversight.** The Animal Care and Protective  
8 Services Division of the Neighborhoods Department shall oversee the  
9 project described herein.

10 **Section 7. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
11 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
12 without the Mayor's signature.
