AN ORDINANCE MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AND APPROPRIATING \$6,199,837.67, INCLUDING \$4,200,000.00 IN FUNDS AVAILABLE FROM SETTLEMENT OF A CONTRACT DISPUTE BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE ("CITY") AND APPLICATIONS SOFTWARE TECHNOLOGY LLC ("AST") TO A NEW PROJECT FOR NETWORK INFRASTRUCTURE UPGRADE AND \$1,999,837.67 BETWEEN ACCOUNTS IN THE ENTERPRISE FINANCIAL AND RESOURCE MANAGEMENT SOLUTION -1CLOUD PROJECT TO BALANCE ACCOUNTS, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 25-012; APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT OF A CONTRACT DISPUTE BETWEEN THE CITY ANDAST; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, A SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND AST; AMENDING THE 2025-2029 FIVE-YEAR IT SYSTEM DEVELOPMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2024-507-E; AMENDING ORDINANCE 2024-504-E, THE FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 BUDGET, TO REPLACE THE SCHEDULE B4A; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE TECHNOLOGY SOLUTIONS DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on March 28, 2018, the City of Jacksonville ("City") and Applications Software Technology LLC ("AST") entered into that

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certain "Master Services Agreement between City of Jacksonville and Applications Software Technology LLC for Enterprise Resource Planning SaaS System Solution" ("Contract"); and

WHEREAS, a contract dispute arose between the City and AST concerning amounts owed by the City to AST under the Contract ("Dispute"); and

WHEREAS, the City and AST wish to avoid lengthy and expensive litigation with an uncertain outcome, and accordingly, have reached a settlement of their Dispute subject to review and approval by the City Council pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 112 of the City's Ordinance Code; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the funds saved by settling the Dispute will be used for the Network Infrastructure Upgrade project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interests of the City and the public that the Dispute be resolved without resort to litigation, costs and expenses; now therefore

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Findings. The recitals set forth herein are true and correct.

Section 2. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

 The funding above is an appropriation of funds from the DM Capital Professional Services account to the DM Computer Equipment and Software account (\$4,200,000.00) which is available due to the settlement of the Dispute (as hereinafter defined) and to be designated for the Network Infrastructure Upgrade project (the "Project") and to the DM Internal Service - Capital Expense account (\$1,999,837.67) within the IT System development Fund to balance the account.

Section 3. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 2 above is to provide funding in connection with the Project. The Project will improve overall network infrastructure resilience and security to support the City's first responders, to ensure high availability of City services to the community of Jacksonville and strengthen the continuity of operations for the City's workforce.

Settlement Approval and Authorization. The Settlement Agreement between the City and AST ("Settlement Agreement") attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** is hereby approved in accordance with Section 112.307, Ordinance Code. The Mayor, or her designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver the Settlement Agreement for and on behalf of the City.

Development Plan Approved by Ordinance 2024-507-E. The 2025-2029 Five-Year IT System Development Plan, approved by Ordinance 2024-507-E, is hereby amended by substituting in the place of Exhibit 1 to Ordinance 2024-507-E, the Fiscal Year 2025-2029 IT System Development Projects schedule, attached hereto as Exhibit 3, and incorporated herein by this reference. Ordinance 2024-507-E is hereby further amended by including the Enterprise Financial and Resource Management Solution - 1Cloud and Network Infrastructure Upgrade project information sheets, attached hereto as Exhibit 4, and
