WHEREAS, 21 Section 5.11 of the Jacksonville City Charter 22 requires the City Council to provide for an annual independent audit, 23 certified by an unqualified opinion, of the accounts and financial transactions of the consolidated government; and 24

25 WHEREAS, Section 102.116, Ordinance Code, requires the use of requests for proposal to select the auditor to perform the annual 26 27 independent audit of the City and any electing independent agency; 2.8 and

29 WHEREAS, Carr, Riggs & Ingram, LLC, submitted a proposal to 30 the City and was the highest ranked audit firm meeting or exceeding the specification; and 31

WHEREAS, the intent of City Council is to contract for auditing services for three fiscal years ending September 30, 2027, with the option for two one-year extensions; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Government requires that Federal Grant
Funds be audited together with local, state and other funds in order
to perform a single audit of the City; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Approval and Authorization to Execute Agreement 8 9 and Engagement of Independent Auditor. The City Council hereby 10 approves and authorizes the Council President, or his designee, to execute the Master Services Agreement and Engagement Letters between 11 the City of Jacksonville and Carr, Riggs & Ingram, LLC, 12 in substantially the forms placed **On File** with the Legislative Services 13 Division (collectively, the "Agreement"). The independent auditor 14 15 firm of Carr, Riggs & Ingram, LLC, is hereby engaged to perform an audit of the accounts and transactions of the City for the fiscal 16 17 years ending September 30, 2025, 2026 and 2027 in accordance with the terms of the Agreement. 18

19 Section 2. Auditor's Fees. The City agrees to pay the 20 independent auditor engaged firm herein the fees for its services for 21 the three fiscal years ending September 30, 2027, as stated in the 22 Agreement. For the fiscal years ending September 30, 2025, 2026 and 2027 the fees will not exceed \$425,000, \$440,000, and \$455,000, 23 24 respectively. The total maximum fee shall not exceed \$1,320,000, subject to the availability of budgeted funds. To the extent 25 26 practicable, the Council Auditor's Office is directed to make 27 available to the independent auditor engaged hereby a maximum number 28 of hours to be provided by the Council Auditor's Office of six hundred 29 (600) hours annually. The total maximum fee payable to Carr, Riggs & Ingram, LLC, shall not be reduced by reason of such services furnished 30 by the Council Auditor's Office. 31

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
