9 AUTHORIZED BY THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND  
10 ECONOMIC SECURITY (CARES) ACT TO BE USED TO  
11 PREVENT, PREPARE FOR, AND RESPOND TO THE  
12 CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC (COVID-19) AMONG  
13 INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES WHO ARE HOMELESS OR  
14 RECEIVING HOMELESS ASSISTANCE, AND TO SUPPORT  
15 ADDITIONAL HOMELESS ASSISTANCE AND  
16 HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION ACTIVITIES TO MITIGATE  
17 THE IMPACTS OF COVID-19, AS INITIATED BY B.T.  
18 20-099; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

20 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

21 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,  
22 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
23 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
24 the accounts listed in subsection (b):

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1 (c) Explanation of appropriation:

2 The funding above is an appropriation of Emergency  
3 Solutions Grant funds from the U. S. Department of  
4 Housing and Urban Development and authorized by the  
5 Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES)  
6 Act.

7 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
8 Section 1 is to provide special ESG-CV funds to be used to prevent,  
9 prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19)  
10 among individuals and families who are homeless or receiving  
11 homeless assistance, and to support additional homeless assistance  
12 and homelessness prevention activities to mitigate the impacts of  
13 COVID-19. In addition, the ESG-CV funds may be used to cover or  
14 reimburse allowable costs incurred by a locality before the award  
15 of funding, including prior to the signing of the CARES Act. Up to  
16 ten percent (10%) of funds may be used for administrative costs.

17 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
18 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
19 without the Mayor's signature.
