9 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$258,209.11 FROM  
10 TRAIL RIDGE LANDFILL MITIGATION FUNDS TO  
11 PROVIDE FUNDING FOR LIGHTS AT YELLOW WATER  
12 BALLFIELDS (\$101,254.36), BALDWIN BASEBALL  
13 ITEMS (\$8,202.30), MAXVILLE PARK DRAINAGE  
14 (\$143,752.45) AND CONTINGENCY (\$5,000);  
15 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PARKS,  
16 RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT,  
17 DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS UPON INVOICES, AND  
18 ACCOUNTING/REVERTER OF ANY UNSPENT FUNDS;  
19 INVOKING THE EXCEPTION OF 126.107(G)  
20 (EXEMPTIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS),  
21 CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), *ORDINANCE*  
22 *CODE*, TO PROCURE THE GOODS AND SERVICES OF B&G  
23 ELECTRICAL, J.B. COXWELL CONTRACTING, INC. AND  
24 BURBANK SPORT NETS; AMENDING THE 2020-2024  
25 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED  
26 BY ORDINANCE 2019-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR  
27 THE PROJECT ENTITLED "MAXVILLE PARK  
28 IMPROVEMENTS - DRAINAGE"; PROVIDING AN  
29 EFFECTIVE DATE.  
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1        **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

2        **Section 1.        Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,  
3 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
4 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
5 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

6 (The account information is attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 1**,  
7 labeled as "Revised Exhibit 1, Revised Acct Info, February 18, 2020  
8 - NCSPHS," and incorporated herein by this reference)

13        (c) **Explanation of Appropriation** - The funding above is  
14 appropriating \$258,209.11 from Trail Ridge Landfill  
15 Mitigation funds for lights at Yellow Water Ballfields  
16 (\$101,254.36), Baldwin Baseball items (\$8,202.30),  
17 Maxville Park Drainage (\$143,752.45), and for contingency  
18 (\$5,000).

19        **Section 2.        Purpose.** The purpose of this appropriation is  
20 to provide funding from the Trail Ridge Landfill Mitigation Fund to  
21 provide funding for lights at Yellow Water Ballfields (located at  
22 500 Yellow Water Road, Baldwin, Florida 32234) for \$101,254.36, for  
23 Baldwin Baseball items (located at 291 Mill Street West, Baldwin,  
24 Florida 32234) for \$8,202.30, for Maxville Drainage (located at  
25 18065 Pennsylvania Avenue, Jacksonville, Florida 32234)  
26 \$143,752.45, and \$5,000.00 for contingency, for a total cost of  
27 \$258,209.11, as identified in **Exhibit 2**, attached hereto.

28        **Section 3.        Oversight/Disbursement of Funds may exceed**  
29 **Projected Costs/Accounting/Reverter.** The Mayor is requested to  
30 appoint the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department  
31 (the "Department") to oversee the purchase and installation of the

1 improvements. The Department may allocate funding for any of the  
2 projects listed in **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit  
3 2, Revised Quotes, February 18, 2020 - NCSPHS" in an amount more or  
4 less than the projected costs shown in **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled  
5 as "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised Quotes, February 18, 2020 - NCSPHS"  
6 so long as the total costs of the project do not exceed the  
7 appropriated amount of \$258,209.11. The Accounting Division is  
8 hereby authorized to transfer funds from one project to another to  
9 effectuate this so long as the total costs appropriated herein have  
10 not been exceeded. Any funds not utilized for the purposes set  
11 forth in this ordinance shall be returned to the fund of origin by  
12 September 30, 2020.

13 **Section 4. Invoking the exception to Sec. 126.107(g),**  
14 **Ordinance Code.** The City is hereby authorized to procure the goods  
15 and services of B&G Electrical, J.B. Coxwell Contracting, Inc. and  
16 Burbank Sport Nets, as described in **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as  
17 "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised Quotes, February 18, 2020 - NCSPHS."  
18 Funds shall be disbursed only after the final billing invoices have  
19 been delivered to the Parks, Recreation and Community Services  
20 Department. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1  
21 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance*  
22 *Code*, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation  
23 because the supplies or services are to be provided by those  
24 specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that  
25 appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all  
26 other provisions of Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code*, shall remain in  
27 full force and effect.

28 **Section 5. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2019-505-E, being  
29 the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City  
30 and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to  
31 provide funding for the project entitled "Maxville Park

1 Improvements - Drainage." The project is more fully described in  
2 the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit**  
3 **3**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 3, Revised CIP, February 18, 2020 -  
4 NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council  
5 finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next  
6 annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best  
7 interests of the community because such deferral will result in  
8 unnecessary delay in drainage improvements to Maxville Park.  
9 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this  
10 ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
11 Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment  
12 set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an  
13 amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-  
14 Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2019-505-E  
15 shall continue in full force and effect.

16 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
17 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
18 without the Mayor's signature.
