11 ASSISTANCE COMMISSION THROUGH THE STATE OF
12 FLORIDA, DEPARTMENT OF STATE, DIVISION OF
13 ELECTIONS, TO PAY FOR THE MAILING OF SAMPLE
14 BALLOTS, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 24-126;
15 PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS INTO FISCAL
16 YEAR 2024-2025; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
20 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
21 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
22 listed in subsection (b):

30 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation** - The funding above represents
31 investment pool earnings generated from the Help America

1 Vote Act (HAVA) grant from the U.S. Election Assistance
2 Commission through the State of Florida, Department of
3 State, Division of Elections, and will be used for the
4 mailing of sample ballots.

5 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
6 Section 1 is to provide funding to the City for the mailing of sample
7 ballots. The State of Florida, Department of State, Division of
8 Elections, has requested that all remaining funds related to the HAVA
9 grant program be used to close out the program.

10 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in this
11 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year
12 2024-2025.

13 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
14 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
15 without the Mayor's signature.
