In February of 2024, an emergency procurement was approved to assess the cybersecurity posture of the City of Jacksonville, after a high profile attack crippled the neighboring City of Jacksonville Beach. A vendor was engaged, the scope was defined, and over a two-month period, an in depth vulnerability assessment and penetration test was performed on the City of Jacksonville's information systems. Gaps in the City's cybersecurity program have been identified via a 3rd party vulnerability assessment in multiple key areas. Many of the issues that were found by the assessment are due to foundational gaps in the program require that professional service and products be purchased in order to mitigate risk to the City's information systems. These products and services have been redacted from this description due to cybersecurity concerns, but can be detailed and justified separately. The enhancements requested on this budget transfer will integrate into that program and allow the ITD security team to effectively manage the security of an extremely large network with a limited staff. These enhancements serve to increase the confidentiality, availability, and integrity of COJ systems, and reduce cybersecurity risk to our employees and constituents.
