7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$90,000.00 IN GRANT
8 FUNDING FROM END HUMAN TRAFFICKING, INC. D/B/A
9 FLORIDA ALLIANCE TO END HUMAN TRAFFICKING
10 ("GRANTOR"), A NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION
11 CREATED PURSUANT TO SECTION 16.618, *FLORIDA*
12 *STATUTES*, FUNDED THROUGH ITS HUMAN TRAFFICKING
13 GRANT PROGRAM, TO THE PSBU GRANTS/HUMAN
14 TRAFFICKING GRANT PROGRAM FY24 TO PURCHASE
15 EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE TO COMBAT HUMAN
16 TRAFFICKING, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-082;
17 APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HER
18 DESIGNEE, THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, AND THE
19 SHERIFF TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE
20 CITY THE GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND
21 GRANTOR; PROVIDING FOR A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS
22 UNTIL JUNE 30, 2025; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY
23 THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN
24 EFFECTIVE DATE.

26 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

27 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
28 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
29 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
30 listed in subsection (b):

6 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

7 The funding above represents an appropriation of grant
8 funds from End Human Trafficking, Inc. d/b/a Florida
9 Alliance to End Human Trafficking, a not-for-profit
10 corporation created pursuant to Section 16.618, *Florida*
11 *Statutes* ("Grantor"), funded through its Human Trafficking
12 Grant Program to the PSBU Grants/Human Trafficking Grant
13 Program FY24 to purchase equipment and software to combat
14 human trafficking. The grant period commences on the date
15 of execution of the Grant Agreement and continues through
16 June 30, 2025. No local match is required.

17 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
18 Section 1 is to utilize private grant funding from Grantor to deploy
19 new technology and enhance existing technology to be used to
20 investigate human trafficking cases. A copy of the Grant Agreement
21 between the City and Grantor outlining the terms and conditions
22 relative to the grant and use of the grant funds is attached hereto
23 as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Grant
24 Agreement").

25 **Section 3. Approval and Authorization.** The Grant Agreement
26 is hereby approved and the Mayor, or her designee, the Corporation
27 Secretary and the Sheriff are hereby authorized to execute and deliver
28 on behalf of the City the Grant Agreement. The foregoing approval and
29 authorization is in addition to, and not a limitation on, all
30 authorizations set forth in Chapter 117 (Grants), *Ordinance Code*.

31 **Section 4. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in Section 1

1 of this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover until June 30,
2 2025.

3 **Section 5. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
4 shall oversee administration of the grant and project described
5 herein.

6 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
7 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
8 without the Mayor's signature.
