5 A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE COUNCIL'S SUPPORT
6 FOR LOCAL BILL J-1, TO BE CONSIDERED BY THE DUVAL
7 COUNTY LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION; AMENDING CHAPTER
8 87-471, LAWS OF FLORIDA, AS AMENDED BY CHAPTERS
9 2011-255, 2016-248, 2017-213, AND 2022-259, LAWS
10 OF FLORIDA, TO ADD A SPECIAL ZONE TO BE KNOWN AS
11 THE NORTH FLORIDA KEYS CORRIDOR IN JACKSONVILLE,
12 FLORIDA, SO AS TO PROVIDE AN EXCEPTION TO
13 §561.20(1), *FLORIDA STATUTES*, FOR SPACE AND
14 SEATING REQUIREMENTS FOR LIQUOR LICENSES FOR
15 RESTAURANTS IN THE NORTH FLORIDA KEYS CORRIDOR;
16 PROVIDING FOR ADVERTISING REQUIREMENTS FOR LOCAL
17 PROPONENTS; DIRECTING THE DUVAL DELEGATION
18 COORDINATOR TO FORWARD TO MUNICODE ANY STATE LAW
19 CHANGE WHICH EFFECTUATES THIS REQUEST; PROVIDING
20 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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22 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Support of Local Bill J-1.** The Council hereby
24 expresses its support of Local Bill J-1, to be considered by the
25 Duval County Legislative Delegation, for the 2023 State Legislative
26 Session. Said Local Bill J-1 provides an exception to Section
27 561.20(1), Florida Statutes, to a specific area in Jacksonville to
28 allow for modified space and seating requirements for restaurants
29 seeking liquor licenses within that area.

30 (a) **The North Florida Keys Corridor.** By action of J-1, an
31 additional Corridor to be known as the North Florida Keys

1 Corridor is being requested by amending Chapter 87-471 Laws
2 of Florida, as amended by Chapters 2011-255, 2016-248,
3 2017-213, and 2022-259, Laws of Florida. A true and
4 correct copy of said Local Bill J-1 is attached hereto as
5 **Exhibit 1.** A geographic legal description and map
6 depicting the area for the North Florida Keys Corridor is
7 attached to **Exhibit 2.** Additionally, this J-bill approves
8 an exception to §561.20(1), Florida Statutes for space and
9 seating limitations to 50 seats and 1,000 square feet
10 within the North Florida Keys Corridor.

11 **Section 2. State J-bill process.** The House of
12 Representative sponsor will combine **Exhibit 1** and **Exhibit 2** into one
13 J-bill to be delivered to House Bill Drafting. The respective local
14 proponents will be responsible for complying with the provisions of
15 the Local Bill Filing Manual including but not limited to advertising
16 and public hearing requirements. The Duval Delegation Local Bill
17 hearing will occur on January __, 2023, in the City Council Chambers.

18 **Section 3. Directing the Duval Delegation Coordinator to**
19 **Forward to Municode any State Law Change which Effectuates this**
20 **request.** The Duval Delegation Coordinator is hereby directed to
21 forward any state law change in the 2023 State Legislative Session
22 that effectuates this request so that, if approved, the new law shall
23 also be placed in Part B-Related Laws, of the Charter and Related
24 Laws of the City of Jacksonville so that it can be catalogued with
25 other changes affecting the City of Jacksonville approved by special
26 act of the Legislature.

27 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This resolution shall become
28 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
29 without the Mayor's signature.
