8 OPERATIONAL EXPENSES, INCLUDING THE PURCHASE OF  
9 EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES, DURING FISCAL YEAR 2021-  
10 2022 AND TO LEVERAGE A CURRENT, TIME-LIMITED  
11 REIMBURSEMENT GRANT FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT  
12 OF HEALTH TO FUND ACTIVITIES DESIGNED TO COMBAT  
13 TROPICAL STORM-INDUCED MOSQUITO INFESTATIONS  
14 AND MOSQUITO-BORNE VIRUS OUTBREAKS, WITH NO  
15 LOCAL MATCH, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 22-058;  
16 PURPOSE OF THE APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING AN  
17 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,  
21 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
22 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
23 listed in subsection (b):

1 The funding above comprises an appropriation of \$161,918.00  
2 from Mosquito Control State Fund 00112 fund balance to  
3 supplement operational line items in the Mosquito Control  
4 Division General Funds budget for fiscal year (FY) 2021-  
5 2022.

6 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
7 Section 1 is to transfer \$161,918.00 from Mosquito Control State Fund  
8 00112 fund balance to cover operational expenses for the Mosquito  
9 Control Division during FY 2021-2022 including, but not limited to,  
10 the purchase of spray equipment, an Aft Tail Rotor Driveshaft  
11 (MD500E), Administration vehicle replacement, control products, and  
12 replacement of security fencing at the 12-acre facility located at  
13 1321 Eastport Road. In addition, these funds will be used to leverage  
14 a current, time-limited reimbursement grant from the Florida  
15 Department of Health to assist the Mosquito Control Division with  
16 upgrading local capability to counteract tropical storm-induced  
17 mosquito infestations and mosquito-borne virus outbreaks. No local  
18 match is required.

19 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
20 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
21 without the Mayor's signature.
