funds in the amount of \$5,177,094.00 from the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("FDEP") for the McCoy's Creek Branches Project (the "Project"). The required local match in the amount of \$5,177,094.00 has been met through Capital Improvement Plan appropriations.

7 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to receive and allocate FDEP's funding for the Project 8 9 which consists of restoring the natural function of approximately 10 4,752 linear feet of stream and the improvement of the north and south branches and the beginnings of McCoy's Creek downstream. These 11 improvements are to reduce flooding in the area and improve 12 recreational opportunities. The term of the grant commenced on October 13 31, 2023 and ends on September 30, 2026, pursuant to that certain 14 State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection Standard 15 Grant Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the State of 16 Florida Department of Environmental Protection Standard Grant 17 Agreement (Agreement Number: 23FRP04) which has been placed On File 18 with the Legislative Services Division and incorporated herein by 19 20 this reference.

21 Section 3. Oversight. The Department of Public Works, 22 Engineering and Construction Management Division, shall oversee the 23 administration of the grant and Project described herein.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
