ORDINANCE 2024-548

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THAT CERTAIN USE AND OCCUPANCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) AND THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE (THE "AGREEMENT") FOR THE CITY'S USE OF THE AIRSPACE ABOVE AND/OR BELOW THE GRADELINE OF THE APPROXIMATELY 6 ACRE PARCEL LOCATED AΤ THE RIGHT-OF-WAY INTERSTATE 95 AT FULLER WARREN BRIDGE, FOR CITY EVENTS AND PUBLIC USE, FOR A THIRTY YEAR TERM COMMENCING ON THE EXECUTION DATE OF AGREEMENT, AT A RENTAL RATE OF \$0.00 PER YEAR, AND AUTHORIZING TECHNICAL CHANGES TO AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE **EMERGENCY** PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Execution Authorized. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver that certain Use and Occupancy Agreement between the State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and the City of Jacksonville ("City") in substantially the same form as has been placed On File with the Legislative Services Division (the

"Agreement"), with such "technical" changes as herein authorized. The Agreement is for the use and occupancy of the airspace above and/or below the gradeline of the approximately 6 acre parcel located at the right-of-way under Interstate 95 at Fuller Warren Bridge (the "Property"), inclusive of any existing improvements, structures, and facilities located thereon as more particularly described in the Agreement, for a 30-year term commencing on the execution date of the Agreement. The Agreement authorizes the City's use of the Property for events, parking, use of the Emerald Trail, and use of the skate park for a public purpose. The City shall maintain at its cost the structures and area within Property in good condition, in accordance with the terms of the Agreement.

The Agreement may include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or her designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Agreement by the Mayor or her designee. No modification to the Agreement may increase the financial obligations or the liability of the City and any such modification shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval of the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and all other appropriate action required by law. "Technical" is herein defined as including, but not limited to, changes in legal descriptions and surveys, descriptions of infrastructure improvements and/or any road project, ingress and egress, easements and rights of way, performance schedules (provided that no performance schedule may be extended for more than one year without Council approval), design standards, access and site plan, which have no financial impact.

Section 2. Oversight Department. The Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services shall oversee administration of the Agreement described herein.

1	Section 3. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant
2	to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this
3	legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that there
4	is an immediate need to open to the public the portions of the
5	Property that have been completed including the skate park.
6	Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become
7	effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
8	without the Mayor's signature.
