7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$114,945.97 FROM THE
8 SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND (THE "FUND")
9 TO FUND VARIOUS CRIME PREVENTION AND LAW
10 ENFORCEMENT EXPENDITURES AND ACTIVITIES
11 INCLUDING: (1) TRANSFERRING \$7,500.00 FROM THE
12 FUND TO THE TEEN DRIVER SPECIAL REVENUE FUND IN
13 ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 111.365, *ORDINANCE CODE*,
14 TO FUND THE TEEN DRIVER CHALLENGE PROGRAM; (2)
15 TRANSFERRING \$7,500.00 FROM THE FUND TO THE
16 POLICE EXPLORER TRUST FUND IN ACCORDANCE WITH
17 SECTION 111.340, *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO FUND THE
18 JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE ("JSO") POLICE
19 EXPLORER POST; (3) ALLOCATING \$20,000.00 TO BE
20 USED FOR THE HOMEWARD BOUND PROGRAM; AND (4)
21 \$79,945.97 FOR DONATIONS TO HUBBARD HOUSE, INC.
22 (\$9,945.97), NORTH FLORIDA COUNCIL, INC., BOY
23 SCOUTS OF AMERICA (\$10,000.00), OPERATION SAVE
24 OUR SONS, INC. (\$15,000.00), M.A.D. D.A.D.S.,
25 JACKSONVILLE CHAPTER, INC. (\$15,000.00), BIG
26 BROTHERS BIG SISTERS OF NORTHEAST FLORIDA, INC.
27 (\$5,000.00), AND DOWNTOWN VISION ALLIANCE, INC.
28 (\$25,000.00) (THE "DONEES"), IN ACCORDANCE WITH
29 SECTION 932.7055(5), FLORIDA STATUTES, AS
30 INITIATED BY B.T. 24-092; APPROVING, AND
31 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE

1 CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON
2 BEHALF OF THE CITY CERTAIN MISCELLANEOUS
3 APPROPRIATIONS AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF
4 JACKSONVILLE AND EACH OF THE DONEES
5 RESPECTIVELY; WAIVING SECTION 110.112 (ADVANCE
6 OF CITY FUNDS; PROHIBITION AGAINST), PART 1 (THE
7 CITY TREASURY), CHAPTER 110 (CITY TREASURY),
8 ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR ADVANCE PAYMENT TO
9 THE DONEES; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE
10 JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN
11 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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13 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

14 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
15 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
16 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
17 listed in subsection (b):

19 this reference)

24 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

25 The funding above represents an appropriation of
26 \$114,945.97 in Contributions from Private Sources within
27 the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund (the "Fund") to
28 other City funds for various crime prevention and law
29 enforcement expenditures and activities and for donations
30 to various organizations set forth herein, in accordance
31 with the *Ordinance Code* and Section 932.7055, *Florida*

1 *Statutes*, as more specifically outlined herein.

2 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
3 Section 1 is to transfer \$7,500.00 from the Fund to the Teen Driver
4 Special Revenue Fund for the Teen Driver Challenge Program in
5 accordance with Section 111.365, *Ordinance Code*; transfer \$7,500.00
6 from the Fund to the Police Explorer Trust Fund for the JSO Police
7 Explorer Post in accordance with Section 111.340, *Ordinance Code*;
8 \$20,000.00 to the Homeward Bound Program, and \$79,945.97 for donations
9 to Hubbard House, Inc. (\$9,945.97), North Florida Council, Inc., Boy
10 Scouts of America (\$10,000.00), Operation Save Our Sons, Inc.
11 (\$15,000.00), M.A.D.D.A.D.S., Jacksonville Chapter, Inc.
12 (\$15,000.00), Big Brothers Big Sisters of Northeast Florida, Inc.
13 (\$5,000.00), and Downtown Vision Alliance, Inc. (\$25,000.00), to
14 support drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime
15 prevention, safe neighborhood, or school resource officer programs,
16 and other law enforcement purposes. A Certification from the
17 Jacksonville Sheriff's Office that the subject appropriation from the
18 Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund complies with Section 932.7055,
19 *Florida Statutes*, is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated
20 herein by this reference.

21 **Section 3. Approval and Authorization.** There is hereby
22 approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation
23 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of
24 the City those certain Miscellaneous Appropriations Agreements
25 between the City of Jacksonville and Hubbard House, Inc., North
26 Florida Council, Inc., Boy Scouts of America, Operation Save Our
27 Sons, Inc., M.A.D. D.A.D.S., Jacksonville Chapter, Inc., Big Brothers
28 Big Sisters of Northeast Florida, Inc., and Downtown Vision Alliance,
29 Inc. (the "Donees"), respectively, in substantially the forms placed
30 **On File** with the Legislative Services Division and incorporated herein
31 by this reference (the "Agreements").

1 **Section 4. Waiving Section 110.112, Ordinance Code.**

2 Section 110.112 (Advance of City funds; prohibition against), Part 1
3 (The City Treasury), Chapter 110 (City Treasury), *Ordinance Code*, is
4 hereby waived to allow for advance payment to the Donees as provided
5 in the Agreements.

6 **Section 5. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
7 shall oversee the Agreements described herein.

8 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
9 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
10 without the Mayor's signature.
