A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE WEEK OF APRIL 7-13, 2024, AS NATIONAL LIBRARY WEEK IN JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Jacksonville Public Library has been an enduring cornerstone of our community since its inception in 1878, steadfastly providing free access to knowledge, culture, and essential community resources for well over a century; and

WHEREAS, Jacksonville Public Library has exhibited remarkable growth and transformation throughout its history, progressing from its humble beginnings to its current stature as a dynamic and thriving institution, comprising a Main Library and 20 additional locations, each dedicated to serving the diverse and evolving needs of our city; and

WHEREAS, the library system has consistently demonstrated its adaptability, responding to the ever-changing demands of Jacksonville's residents by offering a wide spectrum of services, including live events, public computer access, a Memory Lab that enables individuals to digitize precious photographs and videos, and free online courses; and

WHEREAS, in 2023 library locations were visited over 2 million times, more than 4.6 million items were borrowed, and an impressive total of 8,000 live events were hosted, including Jax Book Fest, an event that drew thousands of attendees and gave visitors the opportunity to hear from and meet renowned New York Times bestselling authors for free; and

WHEREAS, National Library Week, an annual celebration,

presents a unique opportunity to acknowledge the valuable role that libraries, librarians, and library workers play in the transformation of lives, the fortification of communities, and the cultivation of a genuine love for literacy and lifelong learning; and

WHEREAS, in observance of National Library Week 2024, the Jacksonville Public Library has set ambitious objectives, including having 25,000 individuals with library cards to borrow library materials, and bringing over 600 Duval County residents into the community of library cardholders, affirming the city's deep-seated appreciation for the dedicated staff and invaluable services of the library; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City of Jacksonville recognizes April 7-13, 2024 as National Library Week in Jacksonville and encourages all citizens to visit one of Jacksonville Public Library's 21 locations or borrow items online, and to express their appreciation for Jacksonville Public Library publicly with friends, colleagues, and family members in person and/or on social media channels.
