The funding above represents a transfer of fund balance derived from investment pool earnings and de-appropriated projects in the total amount of \$3,840,199.91 to fund the

Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to transfer fund balance derived from investment pool earnings and de-appropriated projects to fund construction of the Emerald Trail S-line to Stone Street Improvements which will connect the south end of the existing S-line trail to the intersection of Park Street and Stonewall Street. This expansion will provide multiple access points to the S-line trail for residents of the Lavilla and Brooklyn neighborhoods. In addition, this infrastructure improvement will enable future connection to the programmed McCoy's Creek Greenway and establishes opportunity to transition to the City's planned cycle track project along Park Street. The City will incur no additional debt to complete the Project.

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2020-505-E, adopting the 2021-2025 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to transfer funds from investment pool earnings to fund the completion of the Project, as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the

best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay completion of the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2020-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2020-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested to enable the City to award and execute a contract with the Project construction low bidder prior to expiration of the bids. Failure to issue an award and execute a contract prior to the bids expiring will require a rebid of the Project and may result in increased costs to the City.
