## ORDINANCE 2024-968-E

Introduced by the Transportation, Utilities and Energy Committee and

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 745 (ADDRESSING AND STREET NAMING REGULATIONS), ORDINANCE CODE; RENAMING "WICKER ROAD", LOCATED SOUTH CASTLEBERRY ROAD IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 8, TO "ALEXIS ROAD"; WAIVING THE REQUIREMENT SUBSECTION 745.105(C), ORDINANCE CODE, THAT THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT SEND WRITTEN NOTIFICATIONS TO AFFECTED PROPERTY OWNERS; WAIVING THE REQUIREMENT OF SUBSECTION 745.105(E), ORDINANCE CODE, THAT THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION REVIEW ALL STREET NAME CHANGES; WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION 745.105(L), ORDINANCE CODE, THAT THE CITY HOLD TWO PUBLIC HEARINGS AT LEAST TEN DAYS AFTER THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT PROVIDES WRITTEN NOTICE TO EACH AFFECTED PROPERTY OWNER OF THE PUBLIC HEARINGS AND PLACE SIGNS IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS ADVERTISING SAID HEARINGS; DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION TO FORWARD A COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE, ONCE ENACTED, TO THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT, ADDRESSING UNIT, AND THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department's Addressing Division received information from a resident who advised they were not receiving mail at the property located at 14274 Wicker Road; and

WHEREAS, the City's addressing data indicates that the road currently known as "Wicker Road" (previously named "Alexis Road") is located south of Castleberry Road while the remaining "Alexis Road" is located north of Castleberry Road; and

WHEREAS, in 1979, the City Council enacted Ordinance 79-914-427 which re-named 6<sup>th</sup> Street to Alexis Road (north and south); a copy of Ordinance 79-914-427 is attached hereto as Exhibit 1; and

WHEREAS, several years later, the City Council enacted Ordinance 85-162-79 which closed the northern portion of Alexis Road, north of Castleberry Drive; a copy of Ordinance 85-162-79 is attached hereto as Exhibit 2; and

WHEREAS, on May 5, 1998, the Chief of the City's Streets and Drainage Division of the City's Public Works Department confirmed that the street name change of "Alexis Road" to "Wicker Road" should have been made solely to the northern portion of "Alexis Road"; a copy of the Memorandum from Lynn A. Westbrook, P.E., Chief of Streets and Drainage to Attached Addressees and a Map of the affected roadways are attached hereto as Exhibit 3; and

WHEREAS, instead, City of Jacksonville records incorrectly reflect a street name change to the southern portion of "Alexis Road" to "Wicker Road"; and

WHEREAS, "Wicker Road" does not exist in Google Maps; and
WHEREAS, the Council seeks to correct this matter by renaming
"Wicker Road", located south of Castleberry Road, as "Alexis Road";
and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department, Community Planning Division, issued a Staff Report with a recommendation for approval to re-name "Wicker Road" located south of Castleberry Drive

back to the original name of "Alexis Road"; a copy of the Community Planning Division Staff Report is attached hereto as **Exhibit 4**; and

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2024, the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee voted to accept the staff recommendation to re-name "Wicker Road" located south of Castleberry Road back to "Alexis Road"; a copy of the minutes of November 6, 2024, meeting of the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee reflecting this action is attached here as Exhibit 5; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Wicker Road Re-Named as "Alexis Road." Wicker Road located south of Castleberry Road is hereby re-named to "Alexis Road" by which name such street and physical location shall be hereafter known and designated. A copy of the map of "Alexis Road" is attached hereto as Exhibit 6.

Section 2. Waiver of Subsection 745.105(c), Ordinance Code.

Section 745.105(c), Ordinance Code, which requires the Planning and Development Department to send two written notifications to affected property owners is hereby waived as there are three residents currently assigned to Wicker Road. However, these three residents are not receiving their mail due to the incorrect addressing data. On November 1, 2024, the City's Addressing Staff mailed letters to the affected residents which provided notice of the November 6, 2024, 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee's meeting but no one objected, commented or attended the meeting (Copies of the letters are attached hereto as Exhibit 7).

Section 3. Waiver of Subsection 745.105(e), Ordinance Code.

Section 745.105(e), Ordinance Code, requiring the Historic Preservation Commission to review all applications for renaming of City streets is hereby waived. The next meeting of the Historic Preservation Commission will occur on December 11, 2024, after final City Council approval of this Ordinance which would cause additional

delays for the residents on Wicker Road who are not receiving their mail.

Section 4. Waiver of Subsection 745.105(1), Ordinance Code. Subsection 745.105(1), Ordinance Code, requiring the City to hold two public hearings at least ten days after the Planning and Development Department provides written notice to each affected property owner of the public hearings and places signs in certain locations advertising said public hearings is hereby waived. Recognizing the affected residents are not receiving their mail, emergency passage of this legislation is requested which leaves insufficient time for proper notice and advertisement of the public hearings as required by the Code.

Section 5. Direction to Chief of Legislative Services. The Chief of Legislative Services is hereby directed to send a copy of this legislation, once enacted, to the Planning and Development Department, Addressing Unit, and the Public Works Department for processing, implementation, and coordination with 911 Emergency, Fire and Rescue Department, the U.S. Postal Service, Google and other affected agencies and organizations.

Section 6. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that residents are not receiving their mail due to the incorrect addressing data.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
