6 AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SURPLUS PERSONAL
7 PROPERTY OF THE CITY; DECLARING THAT CERTAIN
8 2011 CHEVROLET IMPALA (VIN 2G1WD5EMXB1189974,
9 VEHICLE NUMBER 169-30) VALUED AT \$5,300 AND
10 2011 CHEVROLET IMPALA (VIN 2G1WD5EM4B1185838,
11 VEHICLE NUMBER 0185-40) VALUED AT \$4,750 TO BE
12 SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE CITY AND
13 AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS OF THE
14 CITY TO TRANSFER TITLE OF SAID PROPERTY TO
15 NASSAU COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD, LOCATED AT 1201
16 ATLANTIC AVENUE, FERNANDINA BEACH, FLORIDA
17 32034, FOR USE AS PART OF AN ASSIGNED VEHICLE
18 PROGRAM FOR THE NASSAU COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT
19 POLICE, AT NO COST, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION
20 122.812(C), *ORDINANCE CODE*; DESIGNATING THE
21 FLEET MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE FINANCE AND
22 ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT TO MONITOR ACTUAL
23 USE OF SAID PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR A
24 REVERTER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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26 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

27 **Section 1. Declaration of Surplus.** The City hereby
28 declares that certain 2011 Chevrolet Impala (VIN 2G1WD5EMXB1189974,
29 vehicle number 169-30) valued at \$5,300 and 2011 Chevrolet Impala
30 (VIN 2G1WD5EM4B1185838, vehicle number 0185-40) valued at \$4,750,

1 as more particularly described in **Revised Exhibit 1**, labeled as
2 "Revised Exhibit 1, Rev Property Info, September 16, 2019 - TEU"
3 attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference ("Subject
4 Property"), to be surplus to the needs of the City of Jacksonville
5 and authorizes the appropriate City officials to transfer title of
6 the Subject Property to Nassau County School Board, located at 1201
7 Atlantic Avenue, Fernandina Beach, Florida 32034, at no cost,
8 pursuant to Section 122.812(c), *Ordinance Code*. A copy of the
9 certificate from the Chief of Procurement certifying compliance
10 with provisions of Chapter 122, *Ordinance Code*, is attached hereto
11 as **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev Surplus
12 Certificate, September 16, 2019 - TEU", and incorporated herein by
13 this reference. A copy of the property transfer forms is attached
14 hereto as **Revised Exhibit 3**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 3, Rev
15 Transfer Forms, September 16, 2019 - TEU".

16 **Section 2. Public Purpose.** The surplus vehicle is needed
17 by the Nassau County School Board to be used as part of an assigned
18 vehicle program for the Nassau County School District Police. The
19 City of Jacksonville finds that providing the surplussed vehicle to
20 the Nassau County School Board to be used as part of an assigned
21 vehicle program for the Nassau County School District Police is a
22 valid public purpose.

23 **Section 3. Fleet Management Division to Monitor Actual**
24 **Use of Subject Property.** The Fleet Management Division of the
25 Finance and Administration Department will be the designated agency
26 to monitor the Nassau County School Board's use of the Subject
27 Property in accordance with the purposes set forth herein.

28 **Section 4. Reverter.** The disposition authorized herein
29 is conditioned upon the Nassau County School Board using the said
30 vehicle for the purposes set forth herein and is conditioned upon
31 the Nassau County School Board agreeing to convey and physically

1 return the vehicle back to the City of Jacksonville, at no cost to
2 the City of Jacksonville, in the event that the vehicle is not used
3 for those purposes.

4 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
5 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
6 without the Mayor's signature.
