6 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND
7 RESCUE FOR THEIR ACTIONS AT THE STRUCTURE FIRE
8 ON HENDRICKS AVENUE AND FOR THEIR EVERYDAY
9 HEROISM; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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11 **WHEREAS,** on April 18, 2025, the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue
12 Department responded to an emergency call reporting a residential
13 structure fire that included the ignition and explosion of multiple
14 LP tanks in the 3700 block of Hendricks Avenue; and

15 **WHEREAS,** the brave men and women of JFRD raced towards the
16 blaze, and working as a well-coordinated team, they stifled the fire
17 and prevented harm; and

18 **WHEREAS,** the apparatus on the scene that Friday to assist with
19 managing the emergency and protecting public safety: Air-5-B, E-1-B,
20 E-13-B, E-20-B, E-21-B, E-28-B, E-5-B, E-51-B, E-51A-B, E-65-B, Fire
21 12-B, Fire 4-B, Fire 1-B, Fire-9-B, HAZMAT-21-B, L-1-B, L-10-B, L-4-
22 B, R-108-B, R-12-B, R-13-B, R-21-B, R-4-B, Squad-12-B, Squad-14-B,
23 Squad-4-B, TL-21-B, Rehab-5-B; and

24 **WHEREAS,** for Jacksonville Fire and Rescue, confronting danger
25 is all in a day's work, and every day on the job they exhibit
26 courageousness to protect our city; now therefore

27 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

28 **Section 1.** The City Council hereby commends Jacksonville
29 Fire and Rescue for their actions at the structure fire on Hendricks
30 Avenue and for the heroic acts they routinely perform on the job.

31 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become

2 without the Mayor's signature.
