4 **ORDINANCE 2024-31**

5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$229,962.47, IN GRANT  
6 FUNDS AWARDED BY THE U.S. ELECTION ASSISTANCE  
7 COMMISSION THROUGH THE STATE OF FLORIDA,  
8 DEPARTMENT OF STATE, DIVISION OF ELECTIONS, TO  
9 PROVIDE REIMBURSEMENT TO THE CITY OF  
10 JACKSONVILLE (THE "CITY") FOR THE COSTS OF  
11 PURCHASING GOODS AND/OR SERVICES FOR VOTING  
12 TECHNOLOGY UPGRADES OR ENHANCEMENTS, AS  
13 INITIATED BY B.T. 24-022; PROVIDING FOR  
14 CARRYOVER OF FUNDS; PROVIDING OVERSIGHT BY THE  
15 SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE  
16 DATE.

18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal  
20 year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
21 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the  
22 account(s) listed in subsection (b):

29 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation** - The funding above represents  
30 a grant from the U.S. Election Assistance Commission  
31 through the State of Florida, Department of State, Division

1 of Elections, for reimbursement of the City's costs related  
2 to the purchase of election technology upgrades and/or  
3 enhancements (the "Project"). No local match is required.

4 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
5 Section 1 is to provide funding to the City for voting technology  
6 upgrades and/or enhancements to the systems, equipment and processes  
7 used in federal elections to improve election security. A copy of the  
8 Memorandum of Agreement for 2022-23 Election Security Enhancement  
9 Grant between the State of Florida, Department of State, Division of  
10 Elections, and the Supervisor of Elections for Duval County, Florida,  
11 has been placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services.

12 **Section 4. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in Section 1  
13 of this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into fiscal  
14 year 2024-2025.

15 **Section 5. Oversight.** The Supervisor of Elections shall  
16 oversee the Project and the grant described herein.

17 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall  
18 become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming  
19 effective without the Mayor's signature.
