Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year,

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$1,095,861 11 from the Project Closure Contingency FY24 Forward - DM 12 Contingencies account within the Authorized Capital 13 Project Fund (32111) to the Jacksonville Beach LifeSaving 14 Station - Other Construction Costs account to provide funds 15 for capital improvements and repairs to the historic 16 Jacksonville Beach Lifesaving Station (formerly known as 17 the Jacksonville Beach Ocean Rescue Building), located at 18 2 Oceanfront North, Jacksonville Beach, Florida 32250 (the 19 20 "Lifesaving Station"), as more fully described herein.

21 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 22 Section 1 is to provide funds to the City of Jacksonville Beach 23 ("COJB") for capital improvements and repairs to the Lifesaving 24 Station as more fully described in **Exhibit 2** attached hereto.

25 Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall
26 not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2025-2026.

27 Section 4. Authorization to Negotiate, Execute and Deliver 28 Agreement. The Mayor, or her designee, is hereby authorized to 29 negotiate, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation 30 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of 31 the City of Jacksonville, an agreement with the City of Jacksonville

Beach to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville to COJB for 1 capital improvements and repairs to the Lifesaving Station as more 2 3 fully described in **Exhibit 2** in a not-to-exceed amount of \$1,095,861. The Office of General Counsel is authorized to prepare an agreement 4 between the City and the City of Jacksonville Beach, subject to the 5 provisions of Section 110.112 (Advance of City funds; prohibition 6 7 against), Ordinance Code. The agreement shall include the following provisions: 8

- 9 (1) COJB shall use its Procurement/Purchasing Code to procure goods
 and services for capital improvements and repairs to the
 Lifesaving Station and will only expend funds provided by the
 City of Jacksonville in accordance with the provisions of its
 Procurement/Purchasing Code.
- 14 (2) The agreement shall not increase the financial liability of the
 15 City of Jacksonville beyond the funds appropriated herein to
 16 COJB.
- 17 (3) The City of Jacksonville's payment of funds shall be on a18 reimbursement basis.
- 19 (4) If the year-end financial audit shows an amount less than the 20 total City funding appropriated herein and reimbursed to COJB 21 is spent, the difference shall be returned to the City of 22 Jacksonville.

23 Section 5. Oversight Department. The Public Works
24 Department shall have oversight of the agreement described herein.

25 Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 26 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 27 without the Mayor's signature.
