ORDINANCE 2025-382-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,095,861 FROM THE PROJECT CLOSURE CONTINGENCY FY24 FORWARD - DM CONTINGENCIES ACCOUNT WITHIN THE AUTHORIZED CAPITAL PROJECT FUND (32111) TO THE JACKSONVILLE BEACH LIFESAVING STATION - OTHER CONSTRUCTION COSTS ACCOUNT, TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND REPAIRS TO THE HISTORIC JACKSONVILLE BEACH LIFESAVING STATION (FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE JACKSONVILLE BEACH OCEAN RESCUE BUILDING) LOCATED AT 2 OCEANFRONT NORTH, JACKSONVILLE BEACH, FLORIDA 32250 (THE "LIFESAVING STATION"); PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER TO FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO NEGOTIATE, EXECUTE AND DELIVER AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE BEACH FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND REPAIRS TO THE LIFESAVING STATION, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated

sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$1,095,861 from the Project Closure Contingency FY24 Forward - DM Contingencies account within the Authorized Capital Project Fund (32111) to the Jacksonville Beach LifeSaving Station - Other Construction Costs account to provide funds for capital improvements and repairs to the historic Jacksonville Beach Lifesaving Station (formerly known as the Jacksonville Beach Ocean Rescue Building), located at 2 Oceanfront North, Jacksonville Beach, Florida 32250 (the "Lifesaving Station"), as more fully described herein.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funds to the City of Jacksonville Beach ("COJB") for capital improvements and repairs to the Lifesaving Station as more fully described in **Exhibit 2** attached hereto.

Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2025-2026.

Section 4. Authorization to Negotiate, Execute and Deliver Agreement. The Mayor, or her designee, is hereby authorized to negotiate, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City of Jacksonville, an agreement with the City of Jacksonville

1 Beach to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville to COJB for
2 capital improvements and repairs to the Lifesaving Station as more
3 fully described in **Exhibit 2** in a not-to-exceed amount of \$1,095,861.
4 The Office of General Counsel is authorized to prepare an agreement
5 between the City and the City of Jacksonville Beach, subject to the
6 provisions of Section 110.112 (Advance of City funds; prohibition
7 against), *Ordinance Code*. The agreement shall include the following
8 provisions:

- 9 (1) COJB shall use its Procurement/Purchasing Code to procure goods
10 and services for capital improvements and repairs to the
11 Lifesaving Station and will only expend funds provided by the
12 City of Jacksonville in accordance with the provisions of its
13 Procurement/Purchasing Code.
- 14 (2) The agreement shall not increase the financial liability of the
15 City of Jacksonville beyond the funds appropriated herein to
16 COJB.
- 17 (3) The City of Jacksonville's payment of funds shall be on a
18 reimbursement basis.
- 19 (4) If the year-end financial audit shows an amount less than the
20 total City funding appropriated herein and reimbursed to COJB
21 is spent, the difference shall be returned to the City of
22 Jacksonville.

23 **Section 5. Oversight Department.** The Public Works
24 Department shall have oversight of the agreement described herein.

25 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
26 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
27 without the Mayor's signature.
