Design or the museum must commence by June 30, 2024, and be completed by September December 30,2025. Construction of the Museum must commence by December 21, 2025, and be substantially completed by July 31, 2028. Park Design must coincide with the Museum design. The legislation authorizes an Amended and Restated Redevelopment Agreement to replace the Agreement dated May 22, 2023, and a First Amendment to the Cost Disbursement Agreement to align with those new schedules.
