ORDINANCE 2025-322

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$15,500 FROM THE MANDARIN PARK - RENOVATE ADA RESTROOMS - OTHER CONSTRUCTION COSTS ACCOUNT TO THE GENERAL FUND OPERATING SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO OTHER GOVT ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO THE DEEP BOTTOM CREEK DEPENDENT SPECIAL DISTRICT ("DEEP BOTTOM CREEK DSD") FOR ADDITIONAL SURVEY, LEGAL AND OTHER PROFESSIONAL SERVICES, AND PERMITTING COSTS NECESSARY TO OBTAIN PERMITS TO IMPLEMENT DREDGING OF DEEP BOTTOM CREEK; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE FUNDING AGREEMENT FOR DEEP BOTTOM CREEK SPECIAL DISTRICT (THE "AGREEMENT"), ORIGINALLY APPROVED AND AUTHORIZED BY ORDINANCE 2023-92-E, INCREASE THE MAXIMUM INDEBTEDNESS \$15,500 TO A NEW TOTAL MAXIMUM INDEBTEDNESS OF \$30,500 WITH ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE AGREEMENT THESAME EXCEPT AS SPECIFICALLY REMAINING AUTHORIZED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Deep Bottom Creek Dependent Special District (the "Deep Bottom Creek DSD") was created pursuant to Ordinance 2022-489-E for the purpose of providing an appropriate, efficient and effective

mechanism for ongoing maintenance of Deep Bottom Creek; and

WHEREAS, the Deep Bottom Creek DSD continues to make efforts to implement a dredging project for Deep Bottom Creek; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2023-92-E, the City Council appropriated \$15,000 to the Deep Bottom Creek DSD and authorized execution of a funding Agreement outlining the terms and conditions for expenditure of the City funds to assist in defraying the costs for implementation of the dredging project; and

WHEREAS, the Deep Bottom Creek DSD has requested further assistance from the City to offset additional expenditures necessary to obtain the permits required to implement dredging of Deep Bottom Creek; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$15,500 from the Mandarin Park - Renovate ADA Restrooms - Other Construction Costs account to the General Fund Operating Subsidies and Contributions to Other Govt account to provide funds to the Deep Bottom Creek DSD for additional survey, legal and professional services, and permitting costs to obtain permits to implement dredging of Deep Bottom Creek.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville to the Deep Bottom Creek DSD for additional survey, legal and professional services, and permitting costs required to implement work to dredge Deep Bottom Creek. The City funds will be used to conduct an additional pre-dredge hydrological survey, to pay for legal and other professional services and support related to issuance of a Request for Proposals, and to offset other permitting and related support costs necessary to obtain a permit to implement dredging.

Section 3. Approval and Authorization to Execute First Amendment to Agreement. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City a first amendment to the Funding Agreement for Deep Bottom Creek Special District (City Contract No. 70454-23) (the "Agreement"), originally approved and authorized by Ordinance 2023-92-E, to increase the indebtedness by \$15,500, for a new total maximum indebtedness of \$30,500, with all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remaining the same except as specifically provided herein. The first amendment may include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or her designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the first amendment by the Mayor, or her designee; provided however, no modifications to the first amendment may increase the financial obligations of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated herein nor decrease the duties and obligations of the Deep Bottom Creek DSD, and any such modifications shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel and the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification terms. For the purposes of

this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to the City, and any other non-substantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties and responsibility of the City under the provisions of the Agreement.

Section 4. Oversight Department. The Public Works

Department shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
