5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$47,500.00 IN GRANT
6 FUNDING FROM THE FLORIDA FISH AND WILDLIFE
7 CONSERVATION COMMISSION (THE "FWC") FOR
8 REIMBURSEMENT OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE'S
9 COSTS TO REMOVE THREE DERELICT VESSELS IN CITY
10 OF JACKSONVILLE WATERWAYS; PROVIDING FOR
11 OVERSIGHT BY THE NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT,
12 ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY DIVISION; REQUESTING ONE
13 CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
14 DATE.

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16 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

17 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,
18 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
19 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
20 listed in subsection (b):

27 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:
28 The funding above represents an appropriation of \$47,500.00
29 in grant funding from the Florida Fish and Wildlife
30 Conservation Commission (the "FWC") for reimbursement to
31 the City of the costs to remove three derelict vessels

1 located in public waterways within the City.

2 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
3 Section 1 is to appropriate grant funding from the FWC to offset the
4 City's costs for removal of three derelict vessels located in public
5 waterways within the City. Pursuant to that certain State of Florida
6 Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission Agreement No. 20399
7 ("Contract #20399"), the FWC will reimburse the City up to \$27,500.00
8 for removal of one 21-foot white vessel in the state waters of
9 Julington Creek, northeast of Clark's Fish Camp, and one 21-foot
10 green vessel at Mandarin Point in the St. Johns River, south of the
11 Buckman Bridge. Removal of these vessels must occur prior to
12 expiration of Contract #20399 on October 22, 2021. In addition,
13 pursuant to that certain State of Florida Fish and Wildlife
14 Conservation Commission Agreement No. 21034 ("Contract #21034"), the
15 FWC has agreed to reimburse the City up to \$20,000.00 for removal of
16 one 38-foot white Bayliner Cabin Cruiser in the Broward River behind
17 1223 Cedar Bay Road. Removal of this vessel must be completed prior
18 to expiration of Contract #21034 on October 15, 2021. Copies of
19 Contract #20399 and Contract #21034 are **On File** with the Office of
20 Legislative Services.

21 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Environmental Quality
22 Division of the Neighborhoods Department shall provide oversight of
23 the project described herein.

24 **Section 4. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant**
25 **to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency passage of this
26 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the
27 removal of the derelict vessels and submittal of reimbursement
28 requests to the FWC must be completed prior to expiration of Contract
29 #20399 and Contract #21034 as stated herein.

30 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
31 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective

1 without the Mayor's signature.
