

NCSPHS AMENDMENT

The Neighborhoods, Community Services, Public Health & Safety Committee offers the following amendment to File No. 2020-735:

- (1) On **page 1, lines 16, 24, 27 and 29, strike** "B.T. 21-023" and **insert** "Revised B.T. 21-023";
- (2) On **page 1, line 16,** after "21-023;" **insert** "INVOKING THE EXCEPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW DIRECT CONTRACTS WITH CHANGING HOMELESSNESS, INC. AND EDWARD WATERS COLLEGE;";
- (3) On **page 1, line 24, strike** "Exhibit 1" and **insert** "Revised Exhibit 1, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 1, Revised B.T. 21-023, January 4, 2021 - NCSPHS"";
- (4) On **page 2, line 18½, insert** a new Section 3 to read as follows:

"Section 3. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to procure the use of the professional services of Changing Homelessness, Inc. and Edward Waters College, to provide services for Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus Assistance (CDBG-CV). Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code*, shall remain in full force and effect."
- (5) Renumber remaining Sections accordingly;

- (6) Remove **Exhibit 1** and replace with **Revised Exhibit 1** attached hereto, which attaches Revised B.T. 21-023;
- (7) On **page 1, line 1**, amend the introductory sentence to add that the bill was amended as reflected herein.
