Bill Summary: The bill appropriates a total of \$284,000.00 from the Mayor's Task Force Contingency Fund to the Special Events – Martin Luther King, Jr. Activities Budget to support MLK Week 2024 programming.

Background Information: The MLK Week of Service Program is a partnership between the City and its cosponsor United Way of Northeast Florida, Inc. United Way has previously organized a day of service to honor Martin Luther King, Jr.'s legacy. The program involves various volunteer-led neighborhood beautification projects aligned with MLK's legacy, aimed at uplifting the underserved parts of Jacksonville. This appropriation will allow United Way to expand the day of service to a week of service in furtherance of the goals of the MLK Week of Service Program.
