ORDINANCE 2024-459

ORDINANCE MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AND ΑN APPROPRIATING \$398,467.85 FROM THE GENERAL FUND - INTERFUND TRANSFER IN ACCOUNT WHICH REPRESENTS RETURNED FUNDING FROM THE TERMINATION OF THE JACKSONVILLE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE 2023-496-E, INCLUDING \$150,000.00 TO THE JACKSONVILLE UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S HEALTH INNOVATION HUB PROJECT AND \$248,467.85 TO PURCHASE REPLACEMENT EOUIPMENT FOR THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-110; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND JACKSONVILLE UNIVERSITY TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR CERTAIN EXPENSES RELATED TO THE JACKSONVILLE UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S HEALTH INNOVATION HUB PROJECT; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH JACKSONVILLE UNIVERSITY; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS TO FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Findings. It is hereby ascertained, determined, found, and declared that the authorizations provided by this Ordinance are for public uses and purposes for which the City may use its powers as a county, municipality and as a political subdivision of the State of Florida to expend public funds, and the necessity in the public interest for the provisions herein enacted is hereby declared as a matter of legislative determination.

Section 2. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$398,467.85 from the General Fund - Interfund Transfer In account (381910) from returned funding related to the termination of the Jacksonville International Airport Community Redevelopment Agency pursuant to Ordinance 2023-496-E, including \$150,000.00 to the General Fund - Subsidies & Contributions to Private Organizations account (582001) and \$248,467.85 to the General Fund - Specialized Equipment account (564290).

Section 3. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 2 is to allocate \$398,467.85 in returned funding from the

termination of the Jacksonville International Airport Community Redevelopment Agency pursuant to Ordinance 2023-496-E, including providing (1) \$150,000.00 in funding to the Jacksonville University Women's Health Innovation Hub project (the "JU Project"), which will be dedicated to improving women's health related technology, and (2) \$248,467.85 to fund the purchase of replacement equipment for the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department. However, this does not preclude the City Council from providing additional funding to the JU Project through separate legislation.

Section 4. Approval and Authorization to Execute an Agreement Between the City and Jacksonville University ("JU"). Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to negotiate, execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, a funding agreement with JU in an amount not-to-exceed \$150,000.00 (which may be increased to \$250,000 pursuant to separately filed legislation) for funding to the JU Project, which will be dedicated to improving women's health related technology, consistent with the term sheet attached hereto as Exhibit 2, and incorporated herein by this reference, and all other contracts, memorandums of understanding and documents, including extensions, renewals amendments thereto, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel and the City's insurance Management Division for appropriate indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, Ordinance Code.

Section 5. Waiving Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code. The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions),

Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract between the City of Jacksonville (the "City") and JU. JU is a non-profit organization and is establishing the Jacksonville University Women's Health Innovation Hub project, which will be dedicated to improving women's health related technology. The City finds that this direct contract is justified because JU intends to make a significant investment in improved women's health related technology, which is vital for health outcomes and will be a unique way for the City to advance as a health care hub and bring additional high paying jobs to the City.

Section 6. Oversight Department. The Grants and Contract Compliance Division of the Finance Department shall oversee the grant and agreements described herein.

Section 7. Carryover. The funds appropriated by this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2024-2025.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
