Bill Summary: This legislation reduces the number of board members on the Jacksonville/Duval County Council on Elder Affairs needed to be present for quorum to be met.

Background Information: A majority of the current membership of the Council on Elder Affairs, excluding vacant seats, shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of meetings and transacting business. A vacancy shall not impair the ability of a majority of the remaining members to execute all the duties and perform all the functions of the Council on Elder Affairs.
