Bill Summary: This bill appropriates \$15,000 from the Special Council Contingency Account to the Subsidies and Contributions to Private Organizations Account within the Kids Hope Alliance (KHA) Fund to provide funding to Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., Jacksonville Alumnae Chapter, for the May Week Program. Oversight is to be carried out by KHA.

Background Information: This legislation provides an appropriation of \$15,000 from the Special Council Contingency Account to fund a scholarship program administered by Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., Jacksonville Alumnae Chapter (JAC), through its May Week Program. The Program aims to promote youth development in Jacksonville, particularly for black women, by highlighting academic and professional achievement and hosting various educational and empowerment events. Funds will be used to provide college scholarships of up to \$3,000 each for high school seniors.

Policy Impact Area: Youth development; scholarships

Fiscal Impact: This bill appropriates \$15,000 from the Special Council Contingency Account.
