WHEREAS, the Council confirmed the Mayor's appointment in Resolution 2020-156-A of Mr. Joseph DiSalvo to serve a partial term to February 28, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City Council amended, and the voters ratified, changes to Article 21 of the Jacksonville Charter authorizing the Council to appoint 4 Members and the Mayor to appoint 3 Members to the JEA Board; and

WHEREAS, the partial term of Mr. DiSalvo has concluded; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor desires to reappoint Mr. DiSalvo as a member of the governing body of JEA, and have that member seat be designated as the Mayoral appointment; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Confirmation. The Council hereby confirms the Mayor's reappointment of Joseph "Joe" P. DiSalvo, a Duval County resident, as a member of the governing body of JEA, pursuant to
