WHEREAS, Gretchen Mitchell began her career with the Jacksonville Public Library in 1990 as a librarian at the Webb Wesconnett Regional Branch, and over the course of 35 years, has demonstrated unwavering dedication to library services and the citizens of Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Mitchell is a member of both the Florida Library Association and the American Library Association, and holds a Bachelor of Arts degree from Rollins College and a Master of Library and Information Science degree from Florida State University; and WHEREAS, Ms. Mitchell most recently served as Deputy Chief Librarian for Support Services, a role she assumed in May 2018 after previously holding the position of Assistant Director for Support

WHEREAS, throughout her tenure, Ms. Mitchell provided executive oversight of critical areas including facilities, safety and security, finance collection management, and technology services across the library system; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Mitchell collaborated with the Florida State College at Jacksonville (FSCJ) to lead a major initiative to offer hotspots and laptops to students through library locations, helping document the effort in the publication Fostering Student Success: Academic, Social and Financial Initiatives; and

WHEREAS, during Ms. Mitchell tenure as Administrative Supervisor from 2003 to 2009, she was responsible for the operations of seven library branches and later the Main Library, overseeing branch renovations and the construction of new facilities under the Better Jacksonville Plan; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Mitchell has been a committed mentor and leader within the Sunshine State Library Leadership Institute, serving five times as a mentor since 2005 and participating in the Library's mentoring managers program; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Mitchell was honored as the Jacksonville Public Library's Employee of the Quarter in the third quarter of 2008-2009, a testament to her leadership, mentorship, and professional excellence; and

WHEREAS, after 35 years of impactful service, Gretchen Mitchell retired on May 2, 2025, leaving a legacy of innovation, mentorship, and commitment to public service in Jacksonville's library system; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City Council hereby honors and commends Gretchen Mitchell for her 35 years of distinguished service to the Jacksonville Public Library and recognizes the lasting impact of her leadership on the library system as an institution and her impact on the broader community.
