Date of Analysis: July 23, 2025

Type of Action: Levy of City of Jacksonville real and personal property taxes in USD 2-4 (the Beaches cities); authorizing assessment and collection of taxes.

Bill Summary: The bill levies ad valorem taxes on real and personal property for the 2025 tax year for GSD operations in Atlantic Beach, Neptune Beach and Jacksonville Beach at a rate of 8.0262 mills, and authorizes the assessment and collection of the taxes.

Background Information: The City of Jacksonville entered into interlocal agreements with the cities of Atlantic Beach, Jacksonville Beach, and Neptune Beach in 1995, 1996 and 1998, respectively, which established the millage rates as the difference between the City of Jacksonville's General Services District's millage rate and 3.2907 mills.

Policy Impact Area: Property tax millage levy - Beaches

Fiscal Impact: The 2025 operating millage rate levied herein by the Consolidated City of Jacksonville upon property within the General Services District of the City, including only the Second, Third, and Fourth Urban Services Districts represents a 5.94% increase from the 2025 rolled-back rate set forth in Resolution 2025-500-A. Provides for the levy of ad valorem property taxes calculated to produce \$ 1,191,159,774 in revenue to the City General Fund and \$ 41,669,119 to the tax increment districts for the FY25-26 budget.
