6 DRAINAGE SYSTEM REHABILITATION - DSR GENERAL
7 CAPITAL PROJECTS TO THE FLYNN ROAD DRAINAGE
8 IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FOR COMPLETION OF THE FLYNN
9 ROAD DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (THE
10 "PROJECT"), AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-048;
11 AMENDING THE 2023-2027 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL
12 IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2022-505-
13 E TO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE
14 PROJECT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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16 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

17 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,
18 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
19 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
20 listed in subsection (b):

27 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:
28 The funding above represents an appropriation of
29 \$261,000.00 from Drainage System Rehabilitation - DSR
30 General Capital Projects to the Flynn Road Drainage
31 Improvements project (the "Project") to provide additional

1 funding for completion of the Project.

2 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
3 Section 1 is to provide additional funds for the Project to offset
4 the difference between the available Project budget and the low bid
5 received by the City. These funds will cover the estimated costs for
6 construction, engineering, and inspections for the Project and will
7 supplement previously appropriated funds to assist with completion
8 of stormwater piping at Flynn Road with the intent to reduce major
9 flooding in the area.

10 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance
11 2022-505-E, adopting the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
12 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
13 hereby amended to provide additional funding for completion of the
14 Project as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets
15 attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this
16 reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment
17 of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be
18 detrimental to the best interests of the community because such
19 deferral will unnecessarily delay completion of the Project.

20 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
21 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
22 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP
23 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute
24 an amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the
25 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E
26 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

27 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
28 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
29 without the Mayor's signature.
