A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF MEGAN FERER, A CLAY COUNTY RESIDENT, AS AN AFFECTED INDUSTRY REPRESENTATIVE TO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION BOARD, REPLACING DAVID WOOD, PURSUANT TO SECTION 73.101 (CREATED; TERMS OF OFFICE; APPOINTMENT AND REMOVAL), CHAPTER 73 (ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION BOARD), CODE, FOR A FIRST FULL TERM TO EXPIRE SEPTEMBER 30, 2028; ESTABLISHING SUBSTANTIAL ECONOMIC BUSINESS INTEREST IN DUVAL COUNTY, PURSUANT TO SECTION 50.102(B) (MEMBERS OF BOARDS COMMISSIONS), PART 1 (ORGANIZATION), CHAPTER 50 (ORGANIZATION OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), ORDINANCE CODE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appointment Confirmation. The Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of Megan Ferer, a Clay County resident, as an affected industry representative to the Environmental Protection Board, replacing David Wood, pursuant to Section 73.101 (Created; terms of office; appointment and removal), Chapter 73 (Environmental Protection Board), Ordinance Code, for a first full term to expire September 30, 2028.

Section 2. Establishing a Substantial Economic Business Interest in Duval County. Section 50.102(b) (Members of Boards and Commissions), Part 1 (Organization), Chapter 50 (Organization of

Boards and Commissions), Ordinance Code, requires Board and Commission members be either permanent residents of Duval County or to maintain a substantial economic business interest or substantial philanthropic interest, as determined by the City Council, within Duval County. Ms. Ferer currently serves as the Environmental Health Safety and Sustainability Manager for Coca Cola Beverages Florida, LLC located in Duval County, and the City Council has determined this constitutes a substantial economic business interest in Duval County.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
