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5 **ORDINANCE 2019-512-E**

6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$100,000 FROM THE
7 DESIGNATED SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY TO THE
8 CLARA WHITE MISSION FEEDING PROGRAM; APPROVING
9 AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF DOCUMENTS BY THE
10 MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE AND CORPORATION
11 SECRETARY; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE
12 OFFICE OF GRANTS AND COMPLIANCE OF THE
13 DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION;
14 INVOKING THE EXCEPTION TO SECTION 126.107(G),
15 *ORDINANCE CODE*; PROVIDING A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS
16 FROM YEAR TO YEAR UNTIL SUCH FUNDS ARE
17 EXPENDED OR LAPSE ACCORDING TO THE AGREEMENT;
18 WAIVING SECTION 118.805 (ELIGIBILITY TO APPLY
19 FOR PUBLIC SERVICE GRANTS), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO
20 ALLOW RECIPIENT TO BE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR
21 FUNDING UNDER OTHER CITY GRANT PROGRAMS;
22 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

24 **WHEREAS**, the Clara White Mission was founded by Dr. Eartha M.
25 M. White, whose compassion for humanity moved her to action. The
26 Mission has existed for more than 100 years, dedicated to serving
27 the needs of the less fortunate in our community, and after more
28 than a century of service, remains devoted to the humanitarian
29 goals pursued so selflessly by the founder; and

30 **WHEREAS**, the Clara White Mission offers more than meals for
31 the hungry and transitional housing for the homeless. They offer

1 hope and a way out of the misery of a life on the streets, and they
2 provide food and housing, and additionally they also offer
3 vocational programs to put people to work; now therefore

4 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

5 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
6 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
7 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
8 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

9 (Account information is attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 1**,
10 labeled as "Revised Exhibit 1, Rev Acct Info, September 17, 2019 -
11 Finance" and incorporated herein by this reference)

12 (a) Appropriated from:

16 (c) Explanation of Appropriation: the appropriation
17 above is appropriating \$100,000 from Designated
18 Special Council Contingency to subsidies and
19 contributions to private sources for Clara White
20 Mission, Inc. to provide a grant for HVAC repairs
21 and improvements, and kitchen, food preparation and
22 distribution equipment improvements for the Feeding
23 Program.

24 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
25 Section 1 is to provide funding to Clara White Mission, Inc. for
26 HVAC repairs and improvements, kitchen, food preparation and
27 distribution equipment improvements for the Feeding Program.
28 Funding will disbursed to the Clara White Mission, Inc. on a
29 reimbursement basis.

30 **Section 3. Clara White Mission, Inc. (\$100,000)**
31 **authorizing Direct Contracting and invoking the exception to**

1 **126.107(g), Ordinance Code.**

2 **1. Approval and authorization to execute.** The Mayor, or his
3 designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby
4 authorized to execute a grant agreement in accordance with
5 Chapter 118, Parts 1, 2, 4 and 5, *Ordinance Code*, with
6 Clara White Mission, Inc. to appropriate \$100,000 for the
7 2019-2020 fiscal year to be used for the Food Program for
8 HVAC repairs and improvements, and kitchen, food
9 preparation and distribution equipment improvements as
10 more fully described in **Exhibit 2** attached hereto.

11 **2. Invoking the exception to Sec. 126.107(g), Ordinance Code.**

12 The City is hereby authorized to enter into a grant
13 agreement with Clara White Mission, Inc. to provide
14 funding to Clara White Mission for the Food Program.
15 Pursuant to Section 126.107(g), *Ordinance Code*, such
16 procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation.
17 With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions
18 of Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code*, shall remain in full force
19 and effect.

20 **3. Oversight Department.** The Office of Grants and Compliance
21 of the Department of Finance and Administration shall
22 oversee the project described herein.

23 **Section 4. Further Authorizations.** The Mayor, or his

24 designee, and the Corporation Secretary, are hereby authorized to
25 execute the Agreement and all other contracts and documents and
26 otherwise take all necessary action in connection therewith and
27 herewith. The Office of Grants and Compliance, as contract
28 administrator, is authorized to negotiate and execute all necessary
29 changes and amendments to the Agreement and other contracts and
30 documents, to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance, without
31 further Council action, provided such changes and amendments are

1 limited to amendments that are technical in nature, and further
2 provided that all such amendments shall be subject to appropriate
3 legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his or her
4 designee, and all other appropriate official action required by
5 law. "Technical" is herein defined as including, but not limited
6 to, changes in legal descriptions and surveys, descriptions of
7 infrastructure improvements and/or any road project, ingress and
8 egress, easements and rights of way, performance schedules
9 (provided that no performance schedule may be extended for more
10 than one year without Council approval) design standards, access
11 and site plan, which have no financial impact.

12 **Section 5. Carryover.** The funds appropriated hereby
13 shall not lapse but shall carryover as appropriated from year to
14 year until such funds are expended or lapse according to the terms
15 of the City Grant Agreement.

16 **Section 6. Waiving Section 118.805 (Eligibility to Apply**
17 **for Public Service Grants), Ordinance Code.** Receipt of this Direct
18 City Grant will not disqualify the recipient from eligibility to
19 apply for funding under other City grant programs. The provisions
20 of Section 118.805 (Eligibility to Apply for Public Service
21 Grants), *Ordinance Code*, to the contrary are hereby waived.

22 **Section 7. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
23 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
24 without the Mayor's signature.
