7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,595,000.00 FROM
8 GENERAL FUND - VARIOUS TO GENERAL FUND - CURE
9 VIOLENCE TO CONTINUE FUNDING FOR THE CURE
10 VIOLENCE PROGRAM THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 2019-
11 2020, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 19-114; PROVIDING
12 FOR A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS TO FISCAL YEAR 2019-
13 2020; PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL AND AUTHORIZATION
14 TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS; PROVIDING FOR
15 EXPENDITURE OF PUBLIC FUNDS ON FOOD, PURSUANT
16 TO SECTION 106.203(B), ORDINANCE CODE;
17 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF
18 GRANTS AND COMPLIANCE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
19 FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION; PROVIDING FOR AN
20 EFFECTIVE DATE.
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22 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2018-2019 fiscal year,
24 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
25 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
26 the accounts listed in subsection (b):

3 (c) Explanation of appropriation:

4 The funding above is a transfer from General Fund -
5 Various to General Fund - Cure Violence to contractual
6 services and subsidies and contributions to private
7 organizations to continue funding for the Cure Violence
8 program through fiscal year 2019-2020.

9 **Section 2. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in Section 1
10 of this ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into fiscal
11 year 2019-2020.

12 **Section 3. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
13 Section 1 is to provide additional funds for ongoing Cure Violence
14 Program implementation and for training and technical assistance,
15 site operations, social services, data analytics and activities
16 necessary for continued implementation of the Cure Violence public
17 health model violence reduction strategy.

18 **Section 4. Approval and authorization to execute.** The
19 Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby
20 authorized to negotiate and execute agreements, including
21 amendments thereto, subject to the terms, scope and conditions more
22 fully described in **Exhibit 2** attached hereto.

23 **Section 5. Expenditure of Public Funds on Food, pursuant**
24 **to 106.203(b), Ordinance Code.** The Cure Violence program is
25 authorized to expend funds (up to 5% of the total grant in the
26 aggregate) on food and beverage. The purpose of the Cure Violence
27 grant is outreach to the community to effectuate change with the
28 goal of reducing violence. The food will be one source of
29 interacting with the community at large to implement the Cure
30 Violence program.

31 **Section 6. Oversight.** The Office of Grants and Compliance

1 of the Department of Finance and Administration shall oversee the
2 project described herein.

3 **Section 7. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
4 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
5 without the Mayor's signature.
