Bill Summary: This bill appropriates \$152,362 from the Special Council Reserve Contingency account to the District 8 Area Business Improvement Program – Miscellaneous Grants and Aids account. The funds are intended to support the Myrtle- Moncrief- Avenue- B Business Corridor.

Background Information: The Myrtle Moncrief Avenue B Business Corridor Improvement Program was originally established by Ordinance 2021-282-E as the Moncrief Area Business Improvement Program – Phase 1 to assist struggling businesses along Moncrief Road and Myrtle Avenue North. The program has since been expanded by Ordinances 2022-264-E and 2024-163-E to include additional commercial properties along Moncrief Road, Myrtle Avenue, and Avenue B. This appropriation transfers previously allocated funds listed under Council District 10 Strategic initiatives to the appropriate program account to fund additional grants. The Office of Economic Development will continue to oversee the program.
