6 A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING HOUSE BILL 987,
7 DESIGNATING A PORTION OF STATE ROAD 10/WEST
8 BEAVER STREET BETWEEN KING STREET AND ACORN
9 STREET IN DUVAL COUNTY AS "HARRY FRISCH STREET";
10 DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES
11 DIVISION TO SEND A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO
12 THE DISTRICT TWO SECRETARY OF THE FLORIDA
13 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE MEMBERS OF
14 THE DUVAL COUNTY LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION;
15 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 **WHEREAS,** during the 2025 Legislative Session, the Florida
18 Legislature passed House Bill 987, which makes honorary designations
19 of transportation facilities throughout Florida and directs the
20 Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to erect suitable markers
21 for those designations; and

22 **WHEREAS,** House Bill 987 designates that portion of State Road
23 10/West Beaver Street between King Street and Acorn Street in Duval
24 County as "Harry Frisch Street"; and

25 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Section 334.071, *Florida Statutes*, a city
26 or county commission must pass a resolution in support of a particular
27 honorary designation before road markers are erected; and

28 **WHEREAS,** the City of Jacksonville wishes to honor Harry Frisch
29 and requests that the FDOT erect suitable markers designating a
30 portion of State Road 10/West Beaver Street between King Street and
31 Acorn Street in Duval County as "Harry Frisch Street"; now therefore

1 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

2 **Section 1.** The City Council strongly supports House Bill
3 987, designating a portion of State Road 10/West Beaver Street between
4 King Street and Acorn Street in Duval County as "Harry Frisch Street",
5 and hereby authorizes the erection of appropriate signage by the
6 Florida Department of Transportation to commemorate the designation.

7 **Section 2. Directive to Chief of Legislative Services**
8 **Division.** The Chief of the Legislative Services Division is hereby
9 directed to provide a copy of this Resolution to the District Two
10 Secretary of the Florida Department of Transportation and the Duval
11 County Legislative Delegation.

12 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
13 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
14 without the Mayor's signature.
