A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING TIMOTHY WILLIAM "TIM" DEEGAN, CHIEF METEOROLOGIST, FOR HIS REMARKABLE 42-YEAR CAREER AT FIRST COAST NEWS; RECOGNIZING HIS LIFETIME OF SERVICE, COMMUNITY IMPACT, AND INDOMITABLE SPIRIT AS A BELOVED EDUCATOR, ADVOCATE, AND TRUSTED VOICE FOR THE PEOPLE OF JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, there are few names in Northeast Florida more synonymous with grace under pressure, scientific excellence, and unshakable public trust than that of Timothy William "Tim" Deegan, who, for over four decades, has not simply reported the weather, he has been a steadfast guide through sunshine and storm; and

20 WHEREAS, Tim Deegan began his career at KBTX in Bryan, Texas 21 while still a student at Texas A&M University, where he earned his 22 Bachelor of Science in Meteorology in 1981. From his earliest 23 broadcasts on *Good Morning, Bryan & College Station* to his elevation 24 to the status as a certified member of the American Meteorological 25 Society in 1982, Tim displayed an unmatched commitment to scientific 26 integrity and clarity in communication; and

WHEREAS, arriving in Jacksonville in 1982 as a 22-year-old surfer with sun-streaked hair and boundless enthusiasm, Tim joined WTLV as the morning show meteorologist and quickly became a household name; by 1986, he was named Chief Meteorologist, a title he carried with dignity, precision, and purpose, until his final forecast in May 1 2025; and

2 WHEREAS, Tim's leadership helped First Coast News earn 3 WeatherRate's coveted title of *Most Accurate Weather* for five 4 consecutive years (2019-2024), a distinction that only hints at the 5 level of public trust he cultivated through calm delivery, timely 6 alerts, and a profound understanding of Florida's dynamic climate; 7 and

8 WHEREAS, beyond the radar maps and satellite loops, Tim has 9 always been a man of the people, visiting over a thousand schools, 10 igniting curiosity in the hearts of children, sharing his awe of the 11 atmosphere, and even recounting his daring flight into Hurricane 12 Gilbert in 1988 with the Hurricane Hunters, reminding us all of the 13 courage it takes to be a guardian of the truth; and

WHEREAS, Tim's story is also one of partnership; alongside his wife, Jacksonville Mayor Donna Deegan, he has poured his heart into the Donna Foundation, an organization that champions the fight against breast cancer and provides compassionate support to those walking the toughest roads of life; and

19 WHEREAS, Tim is a proud father of three and grandfather of 20 four whose joy in life has always extended far beyond the green 21 screen, whether catching waves on the coast, lending his time to 22 worthy causes, or simply marveling at the majesty of nature with the 23 same awe that first drew him to meteorology; and

WHEREAS, as one of the first 100 meteorologists in the nation to be recognized as an AMS Certified Broadcaster, Tim has not only set the gold standard for scientific reporting, but has also embodied the highest calling of public service, steadfast, humble, and always in tune with the needs of his community; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:
Section 1. The City Council hereby honors Timothy William
"Tim" Deegan for his extraordinary 42-year career in meteorology, for

being a steady voice through turbulent storms, and for standing as a 1 2 beacon of excellence in journalism, science, and civic engagement. The City Council commends Tim Deegan for embodying the values of 3 integrity, compassion, and public trust; for inspiring a generation 4 of scientists and thinkers; and for always reminding us that our 5 skies, no matter how dark, are never without hope. The City Council 6 7 extends its heartfelt congratulations and deepest gratitude to Tim Deegan as he enters retirement.
