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## **ORDINANCE 2024-476**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$154,100 FROM THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT'S DESIGNATED CONTINGENCY TO THE SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO PRIVATE ORGANIZATION ACCOUNT FOR MAYPORT WATERFRONT, INC., D/B/A MAYPORT WATERFRONT PARTNERSHIP ("MWP"), TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO SUPPORT VARIOUS ACTIVITIES AND INITIATIVES BY MWP RELATED TO RESTORATION OF MAYPORT AS Α "WORKING WATERFRONT"; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER SEPTEMBER 30, 2025; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND MAYPORT WATERFRONT, INC. FOR SERVICES RELATED RESTORATION OF MAYPORT AS A WORKING WATERFRONT; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH MWP; PROVIDING OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)

listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$154,100 from the Council President's Designated Contingency to the Subsidies and Contributions to Private Organization account to provide funding to Mayport Waterfront, Inc. d/b/a Mayport Waterfront Partnership ("MWP") to support various activities and initiatives by MWP related to restoration of Mayport as a "working waterfront".

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide City funds to MWP to support various activities and initiatives aimed at restoring Mayport as a working waterfront. The City funds will be used in a variety of efforts including improvements and maintenance to key properties and signage in Mayport, supporting the Florida Youth Maritime Training Commercial Fisherman Apprenticeship Course, hiring a grant writer, and other operational and administrative expenses of MWP.

Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall not lapse but shall carryover to September 30, 2025.

Section 4. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver an agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Mayport Waterfront, Inc., in a not-to-exceed amount of \$154,100, for a term commencing on August 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025, and all other contracts and

documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his designee, and the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, Ordinance Code.

Section 5. Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code, to Allow for a Direct Contract with Mayport Waterfront, Inc. provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract between Mayport Waterfront, Inc., and the City of Jacksonville. This waiver is justified because MWP was established with a primary mission to restore and rehabilitate this important and historic waterfront. MWP works closely with the City's Office of Economic Development to administer a number of initiatives to further the goal of economic development and redevelopment in Mayport including restoration and maintenance of key properties on or near the waterfront and offering training and educational opportunities. MWP maintains a consistent presence in Mayport with important connections to the community and is thus uniquely situated to continue in these efforts.

Section 6. Oversight. The Office of Economic Development shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.

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
