The request is to re-amortize the loan to LiquidProof, LLC (dba Four Fathers Distillery) and extend the

maturity date for the Second Mortgage in favor of the City by a period of ten (10) years, from June 1, 2023 to June 1, 2033.

The subject property is located at 2917 Borden Street, within Level 2 Economically Distressed Area of Northwest Jacksonville. Ordinance 2017-448-E authorized a loan and appropriated \$61,000 from the Northwest Jacksonville Economic Development Fund (NWJEDF) for the purpose of assisting with infrastructure improvements needed to convert the building from a warehouse with office space to a distillery for private label specialty spirits for national distribution.

The improvements were completed in the last quarter of calendar year 2017 and the loan was disbursed in May 2018. The approved loan has a term of 5 years at 3 percent interest, amortized over a 20-year period, with a balloon payment at the end of the 5th year. Based on the existing terms, a balloon payment of approximately \$49,318 was due in June 2023; however, the company has requested an extension to allow them to remain in compliance with their payment obligations while continuing to invest in their project.
