Bill Summary: This bill appropriates \$115,000 — \$90,000 from the Duval County Tax Collector – Tax Collector Miscellaneous Revenue account and \$25,000 from the Duval County Tax Collector – Collection Fees – St. Johns River Water Management District account — to the TCSG Tax Collector General Operations – Financial and Administration – Postage account, to fund increased anticipated postage costs for the remainder of Fiscal Year 2025-2026, as initiated by B.T. 26-085. The bill waives Section 106.303 (Format and determination of amounts appropriated), Subpart A (General Provisions), Part 3 (Appropriations), Chapter 106 (Budget and Accounting Code), Ordinance Code, to allow modification of the Appropriation of Funds Exhibit to facilitate compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

Background Information: The funding represents collections received in excess of budgeted estimates from various special districts for which the Tax Collector retains a two percent commission for collecting and distributing property tax revenue. The appropriation provides for postage costs anticipated to exceed budgeted estimates over the remainder of the 2025-2026 fiscal year. The waiver of Section 106.303 is necessary to allow the Appropriation of Funds Exhibit to take the modified form attached as Exhibit 1, in order to comply with the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. B.T. 26-085, in the form authorized pursuant to Ordinance 2015-428-E and reflecting the Mayor's approval, is on file with the Budget Office.

Policy Impact Area: Tax Collector Operations

Fiscal Impact: \$115,000 appropriation from Duval County Tax Collector revenue accounts, as initiated by B.T. 26-085. No match required.
