Jacksonville University (JU)/WHIN's grant funding request of \$250,000 was approved by the City Council in August of 2024. However, a contract between JU and the City for the initiative was never established because JU was informed by the Grants Department that indirect costs are unallowable, so an amendment to the budget is required. This legislation is requestion to amend the budget by reallocating \$30,123 to Operating Expenses from Indirect Expenses, where the funds will support internet connectivity expenses for WHIN. WHIN is not physically located on the JU campus; it is housed off-site in Jacksonville at the Florida Blue campus (4800 Deerwood Campus Parkway, #300, 32246) and, therefore, must purchase reliable and robust internet access apart from what would be available at the JU campus. As WHIN is focused on innovation and technology related to women's health, internet connectivity is a vital need to support the program.
