The funding above represents an appropriation of \$350,000.00 to the Jax Arboretum-Restroom Sewer Connection project to connect water and sewer to the City's central sewer system at the Jacksonville Arboretum & Botanical 1

Gardens.

2 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this appropriation in 3 Section 1 is to transfer funds from the Neighborhood Enhancement Trust - Pari-Mutuel Account to the Jax Arboretum-Restroom Sewer 4 5 Connection project to connect water and sewer to the City's central sewer system ("the Project"). The Jacksonville Arboretum & Botanical 6 7 Gardens, Inc. has a restroom building with a holding tank that needs to be pumped weekly due to an increased number of visitors. The 8 9 Project will connect bathroom water and sewer to the City's central 10 system. The Arboretum & Botanical Gardens is approximately 1.5 miles from the Best Bet Jacksonville, making it an eligible location to 11 12 receive park improvement funding from the Neighborhood Enhancement Trust - Pari-Mutuel account, per Section 111.925, Ordinance Code. 13

14 Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 15 2022-505-E, adopting the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies is 16 17 hereby amended to reflect the transfer of funds from the Neighborhood Enhancement Trust - Pari-Mutuel account to the Project as more fully 18 19 described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as Exhibit 20 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds 21 that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual 22 budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of 23 the community because such deferral will create an unnecessary delay 24 for the construction of this recreational infrastructure.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.
