Load King paid a purchase price of \$324,000 and provided an additional \$70,000 to relocate the current lessee of the property.  The funds were received and deposited into the Jacksonville Recreational and Environmental Land Acquisition Fund (32103), PRCS Parks & Rec Capital Projects – Parks and Recreation Account (167101). In 2020, Finance Department transferred the funds to the Equity of Pooled Cash Account (104001). The funds must be transferred back to the PRCS Parks & Rec Capital Projects – Parks and Recreation Account (167101) to be expended in accordance with Section 3 of Ord 2019-135.
