ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$95,000.00 ΑN NORTHWEST JACKSONVILLE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT -RESERVES ТΟ THE NORTHWEST JACKSONVILLE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO ALLOW THE CITY TO PARTNER TO Α JTA FUND GRANT FOR Α TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2019-245-E ENTITLED "FULL SERVICE GROCERY STORE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM" (THE "PROGRAM") FOR ONE YEAR, AS INITIATED BY B.T. APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE JACKSONVILLE TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FOR PILOT TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF DEVELOPMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above is a transfer of funds from Northwest Jacksonville Economic Development - Reserves to Northwest Jacksonville Economic Development - Subsidies and Contributions to fund a grant to the Jacksonville Transportation Authority (JTA) for a one-year pilot transportation program.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to allow the City to partner with JTA to fund a grant for a pilot transportation program approved by Ordinance 2019-245-E entitled "Full Service Grocery Store Improvement Program" (the "Program") for one year. The Program will make convenient and reliable transportation to grocery stores available to residents of the Northwest Jacksonville Economic Development Area (the "Area") and incentivize the operation of new supermarkets and healthy food programs within the Area.

Section 3. Approval and authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Funding Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the Jacksonville Transportation Authority for Pilot Transportation Program, attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 4. Oversight Department. The Office of Economic Development shall oversee the project described herein.
